- Manages and maintains all aspects of agronomy for the golf course, property, and club house grounds.
- Develop, implement and manage BMP's for the golf course, property and club houses grounds.
- Responsible for building annual agronomic budget. Develop a sound 12-month agronomic plan, labor plan, and operational budget.
- Demonstrate proactive and effective communication skills. Written and Oral.
- Develop and maintain long-range equipment replacement and infrastructure improvement plan.
