Legacy Award

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Heart of America Golf Course Superintendents Association (HAGCSA) Legacy Award competition offers education aid to the <u>children and grandchildren</u> of HAGCSA members. An **award of \$2,000** is sponsored by the Scholarship & Research funds of the **Heart of America Golf Course Superintendents Association.** The award is administered by The Heart of America GCSA Board of Trustees.

"Blind" applications are submitted for judging to <u>an independent committee</u> consisting of three high school educators and/or three college administrators to protect against bias. All decisions of the committee will be final. Applicants will be notified of their status by mail. All scholarship award checks will be made payable to the applicant and his/her educational institution.

ELIGIBILITY

1. One or more of the applicant's parents or grandparents must have been a HAGCSA member for five or more consecutive years and must be a currently active HAGCSA member in one of the following classifications: Class A, Class B, Class C, Retired-A, Retired-B or AA Life.

The competition is open to natural or adoptive offspring of HAGCSA members. Children or grandchildren of deceased members are also eligible if the member was active at the time of his or her death.

- 2. The student must be enrolled full-time at an accredited institution of higher learning, or in the case of high school seniors, must be accepted at such an institution for the next academic year. Graduating high school seniors must attach a letter of acceptance to their application.
- 3. *Past winners* are ineligible to apply the following year. They may reapply after a one-year hiatus.
- 4. Children of those employed by HAGCSA staff are not eligible for this program.

CRITERIA for SELECTION

- 1. Applicants will be evaluated based on academic achievement, extracurricular and community involvement, leadership and outside employment.
- 2. The student must submit an original essay of up to 500 words. The essay must be original and not previously submitted to HAGCSA.

NOTE: Financial need is not a factor in the selection.

HOW to APPLY

Students must complete and submit the attached application form and supply the following under one cover:

- 1. Transcripts from all high schools and colleges attended.
- 2. Typed original essay.
- 3. Graduating high school seniors must attach a collegiate letter of acceptance to their application.
- 4. All applications must be postmarked by October 31, 2022.
- 5. Additional application booklets may be obtained from HAGCSA Chapter Presidents or the HAGCSA website (<u>www.HAGCSA.org</u>).
- 6. Send the packet to: HAGCSA Legacy Award, Heart of America Golf Course Superintendents Association, PO Box 419264, Kansas City, MO 64141.

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TIPS

Your scholarship application will be judged by its appearance. It is important to remember the following tips:

- 1. Read the instructions carefully.
- 2. Request information that you have to obtain from others early. When your school will be sending transcripts directly to us, check back with the school about a week after you make your request to make sure your transcripts have been sent.
- 3. If you have questions, call the number on the application.
- 4. Try and have your application arrive as early as possible.
- 5. Provide all the information required. Do not submit an incomplete application.
- 6. Do not include extra items.
- 7. Proof all materials. Have one or two other people proof your essay. Use spell check.
- 8. Type your application. If you do not have a computer or a typewriter, go to the computer lab at your school.
- 9. Be neat. If you need additional pages to fully answer a question, use them.
- 10. Use white paper. Do not use staples.
- 11. Make copies of your finished application for reference.

CHECK LIST

- □ Carefully complete each question in application.
- □ Sign where indicated.
- Attach transcripts from all universities and post-secondary schools that include grades from the last completed semester. The transcripts do not need to be official.
- Attach required essay.
- □ If you are a graduating high school senior, attach a letter of acceptance from the college you plan to attend.

DEADLINE

The deadline for submitting application is October 31, 2022. *Must be postmarked by this date.
